2 Production of HFCS in China and forecast, 2006-2015

HFCS' properties and sweetness are similar to sucrose's, and it's much healthier than sucrose. Plus, its price is much cheaper. Many developed countries have used it to replace sucrose for many years. Compared with developed countries like the US and Japan, the production of HFCS in China is still at the early stage. In the [redacted], the first production line of HFCS was launched in Shandong Province, when the capacity of the product in the US has reached [redacted] t/a. As sucrose price has been increasing in the past few years, more and more HFCS producers enlarged their production; the production scale in China has expanded rapidly since 2009. From 2009 to 2011, the capacity of the product climbs from [redacted] t/a to [redacted] t/a, while its output rises from [redacted] tonnes to [redacted] tonnes.

3 Price of HFCS in China, 2011

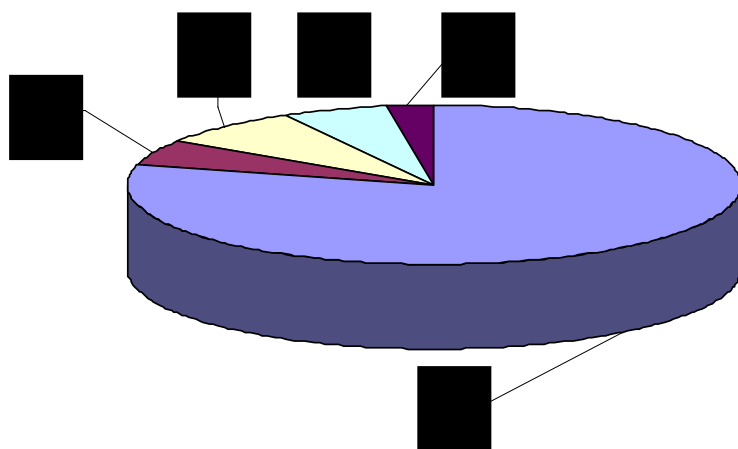
The price of HFCS in China has increased largely and steadily in 2011; the average ex-work price of F42 HFCS jumps from USD [redacted]/t in 2010 to USD [redacted]/t, up [redacted] year on year, and that of F55 HFCS rises from USD [redacted]/t in 2010 to USD [redacted]/t by [redacted]. Entering 2012, the ex-work price is still increasing, with that of F42 HFCS reaching USD [redacted]/t and F55 HFCS' coming to USD [redacted]/t in April.
