3.2.1.1 Producer and distribution



3.2.2 Production technology


There are two kinds of technologies for the production of corn starch, namely wet method and dry method. So far, the former is preferred in China, which is the same for corn gluten meal.

Figure 3.2.4.1-1 Ex-works price of corn gluten meal in China, Jan.-Sept. 2013


